We will be selling pizzas and garlic bread in the church basement after all Sunday Masses on:
Sept 5, Sept 12, Sept 19, Sept 26, and Oct 3.

1. **Please sign up to sell after Sunday Mass on one or two days.** Arrive in the church basement at least 10 minutes before your scheduled start time.
2. Please bring a **pen, calculator, scissors, order forms,** and **money** so that you can make change when someone pays you in cash.
3. Please **wear your uniform when selling.**
4. Keep the top copy of the order form and **fill it out completely.** The bottom portion of the form is for the customer. **Collect payment at the time of the sale. NO ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PROPER PAYMENT ATTACHED. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE PAYMENT IS COLLECTED WHEN THE ORDER IS PLACED.**
5. In addition to selling after Mass you can also sell on your own to your friends and neighbors. Enclosed are a few order forms for your use and more will be available after each Mass or at meetings.

Every Scout should plan to help assemble pizzas in the school cafeteria on **Sunday, October 17TH, beginning at 7:00 am** and continuing until all pizzas are complete and everything is cleaned up. Donuts, juice, and coffee, will be available. **Please bring one of your parents with you.** Try to bring aprons, a large spoon or ladle, and a bucket with a towel or sponge for cleanup. If a few Scouts could bring a broom to sweep the floor it would help.

It is especially important that you **be available at 1:30 p.m.** to take home any pizzas that you sold but were not picked up by the customer. All pizzas will be prepaid but storage is a problem. We will provide you a list of your customers so **please plan to make reminder calls Saturday evening.**

Remember that this is our only fundraiser for the year. We must raise enough money to cover all our expenses, but this can only be accomplished with your support.
