

## 2010-2011 DRESS CODE

DRESS CODE (Note that \*\*\*indicates a change from last year. **Shoes have changed.**)

**STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO DRESS AND PRESENT AN APPEARANCE CONSISTENT WITH STANDARDS OF GOOD TASTE AND APPROPRIATE FOR SCHOOL AND SCHOOL EVENTS. ANY DRESS OR WEARING OF INSIGNIA WHICH CONVEYS THE IMAGE OF GANG MEMBERSHIP, SUPPORTS THE BELIEFS OF HATE GROUPS, MAKES SEXUAL INNUENDOS, OR PROMOTES DRUGS, ALCOHOL, OR TOBACCO IS INAPPROPRIATE FOR SCHOOL AND SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED.**

### *Dress Code Policy*

*Uniforms for students at Assumption are mandatory. Students are required to be neatly dressed and well groomed.*

Dress Code for In-Uniform Days

Assumption Parish School requires uniforms to be worn by each child. The dress code is:

### **Boys' Uniform (All Grades)**

- White dress shirt
- White knit pullover shirt with collar (**no logos**)
- Shirts must be correctly tucked inside (not tucked-out of) the pants
- Navy blue twill pants
- Navy blue corduroy pants with no metal trim
- Belts must be worn if pants have belt loops in Grades 1-8; belts optional for K
- Pants must be worn with the waistline of the pants at the student's waistline
- \*\*\*Solid (no colored trim) white, navy blue or black socks that must be visible without pulling them up to make them visible.
- Navy blue sweater
- Assumption School logo sweatshirts

### **Boys' Optional Winter Seasonal Uniform** (\*\*\*)November 15 through March 15)

White turtleneck (**no logos**)

### **Boys' Optional Summer Uniform** (\*\*\*)March 15 through November 15)

**Navy blue twill uniform walking shorts**—no longer than the top of the knee when the student is standing. Shorts must be worn with the waistline of the shorts at the student's waistline. Shorts may be purchased at any store but must closely resemble the Tom Sawyer uniform shorts.

### **Girls' Uniform (Grades K-5)**

- Green watch-plaid jumper
- White uniform blouse, long or short sleeve, with round or pointed collar
- White knit pullover shirt with collar (**no logos**)—Lace trim is not uniform.
- Blouses must be correctly tucked inside (not tucked-out of) the jumper.
- \*\*\*Solid (no colored trim) white, navy blue, or black socks that must be visible above the top of the shoe without pulling them up to make them visible. Lace trim is not uniform.

- Navy blue, black, or white tights or form-fitting leggings; or solid-colored shorts must be worn under the uniform at all times. Leggings must be the exact legging style sold by our uniform supplier. Sweatpants and other sportswear are not acceptable inside uniform apparel.
- Navy blue sweater
- Assumption School logo sweatshirts

**(Grades 6-8)**

- Green watch-plaid skirt. Skirts may be worn no more than two inches above the top of the knee.
- \*\*\*White uniform blouse, long or short sleeve, with round or pointed collar—no lace.
- White knit pullover shirt with collar (**no logos**)
- Blouses must be correctly tucked inside (not tucked-out of) the skirt
- \*\*\*Solid (no colored trim) white, navy blue, or black socks that must be visible above the top of the shoe without pulling them up to make them visible.
- Navy blue, black, or white tights or form-fitting leggings; or solid-colored shorts must be worn under the uniform at all times. Leggings must be the exact legging style sold by our uniform supplier. Sweatpants and other sportswear are not acceptable inside uniform apparel.
- Navy blue sweater
- Assumption School logo sweatshirts

**Girls' Optional Winter Seasonal Uniform** (\*\*\*)November 15 through March 15)

Navy blue slacks or navy corduroy slacks with no metal trim may be worn in place of the jumper or skirt

White turtleneck (**no logos**)

**Girls' Optional Summer Uniform** (\*\*\*)March 15 through November 15)

**Navy blue twill uniform walking shorts**—no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the knee when the student is standing. Belts must be worn if shorts have belt loops for Grades 1-8; belts optional for K. Shorts may be purchased at any store but must closely resemble the Becky Thatcher uniform shorts.

**All Students K-8**

- \*\*\***Athletic tie shoes only**--low cut, non-marking, and as plain as possible shoe. This is for in-uniform and out-of-uniform days. Shoes should be tied so the shoe stays on the foot and does not present a tripping hazard.
- \*\*\* In the winter months, boots may be worn to and from school but not in school.
- Shirts worn under the uniform shirt or blouse must be plain white--no writing, etc., showing through. Such an undershirt may not extend past the uniform shirt.
- Cosmetics and nail polish may not be worn.
- Jewelry, with the exception of small post earrings and one wristwatch, may not be worn. No jewelry may be worn in a body piercing other than the ears, even if the piercing is new.
- \*\*\*No necklaces are acceptable as uniform. Religious medals, crosses, and scapulars need to be worn under the blouse or shirt so they are not choking hazards.
- Hair color needs to be a color that occurs naturally as a human hair color.
- No bandanas or scarves tied around the head are permitted.

- No clique or group-identifying apparel of any kind.
- Sweatshirts or sweaters tied around the waist are considered out-of-uniform. This is acceptable only during recess.

### **Dress Code for Out-of-Uniform Days**

- Modesty should be considered in appropriateness of clothing fit and style. As Catholics we declare the human body a sacred gift from God.
- Nice shirts (no crop tops, shirts with inappropriate sayings or graphics, mesh shirts, spaghetti straps, or tank tops)
- Nice jeans (no words written across the seat of the pants or rips and tears) and modest shorts, nice sport shorts, slacks or modest dresses or skirts (no cutoffs or snap-pants). Shorts may only be worn from March 15th through November 15th.
- Shorts may not be any shorter than mid-thigh.
- When students raise their hands in the standing position, no midriff should be bare or showing because of pants or tops that are too short
- **Shoes and socks must always follow the uniform code because of safety.**
- Make-up is not acceptable.
- Nail polish is acceptable for out-of-uniform days.

### **Dress Code for Physical Education Classes in Grades 4 through 8**

- White T-shirt with Assumption School logo (with last name across back in some permanent fashion: permanent marker, iron-on letters, sewn or painted)
- Gym shorts from Famously Yours with the School logo on right leg – Do Not Shorten
- Athletic shoe designed for sports and physical activities with socks.

The final decision about a student's uniform compliance rests with the principal. Students are expected to follow the rules without parents and teachers reminding them.
