## GENERAL INFORMATION FOR THE 2011-2012 SCHOOL YEAR

- SCHOOL DAY:** The school doors open at 7:30 AM with the first bell at 7:40 AM. Prayer and instruction begin at 7:45 AM with dismissal at 2:45 PM. Early Dismissal is at 12:30 PM (faculty meeting days, etc.).
- Full Day Kindergarten: 7:45 AM to 2:45 PM (with  $\frac{1}{2}$  day options)  
Parents are welcome to walk their children in on the first day of school.
- TUITION:** Tuition is paid monthly starting the month of July 2011 through June 2012, as follows: \$380.00 per month for one child, \$580 per month for two children and \$693.00 per month for three or more children. **Our tuition and fees include all parent required costs except for field trips.**
- FEES:** The school fees are due and payable before the opening day of each school year. The cost for this year is as follows:

- Bibles, Classroom Subscriptions, Recorder and Book: included for some Grades.
- LUNCH:** A hot lunch program is available at Assumption Parish School for the 2011-2012 school year. Plate lunches and ala carte items are available daily in the school cafeteria. A menu (with price list) is sent home monthly and is available on-line. Children may bring lunch from home and purchase drinks and additional items, if desired. The Meal Card System is used, for your convenience. You make a "deposit" which will be entered into the system and credited to your child's account. You can view your account at any time through a link on the Assumption website. You may also use cash to pay for all items.
- FAST DIRECT:** Service that allows parents to view Report Cards and Grade Books on-line. It provides an opportunity for communication between parents and School Staff.
- PONY EXPRESS:** A weekly "Pony Express" envelope containing school information will be sent home to each family on Thursdays. Each child has a "Pony Express" envelope. Only the oldest/only child will receive the all-school information.
- HOMEWORK** Daily Homework Hotline (Grs. 1-4) is **accessible after 4:00 PM**. Call school at 487-6520, press 3 **HOTLINE:** (wait a few seconds) and choose the desired grade level number (eg. 1, 2, 3, 4). Older students are responsible for their own homework.
- SNOW DAYS:** If it becomes necessary to close school or start later due to inclement weather, announcements will be aired on TV stations FOX, KMOV and KSDK. Watch for "Assumption Parish School - South County" to be closed. You can also check the news channels for on-line lists of school closings.
- If the announcement indicates "snow schedule", doors to school will open at 9:10 AM, classes will begin at 9:30 AM with a regular dismissal at 2:45 PM. Please do not call the school office or the rectory for this information.
- Once school is in session, there will be no early dismissal for inclement weather. If you choose to pick up your child early if weather begins to deteriorate, you must come to the school office and sign your child out. No other carpool children will be allowed to leave with you unless those children's parents have called the school office and you are listed on their emergency cards.
- UNIFORMS:** Please check your parent handbook. (Famously Yours - 842-4424)
- GUARDIAN ANGEL PROGRAM:** A program designed to welcome new families and students to Assumption Parish School.
