

Assumption Early Learning Center Toilet Training Agreement

In order to make toilet training a positive experience for you and your child, we have incorporated a plan to assist in achieving this goal. We have devised an agreement for the parent and the classroom teacher to follow.

- Parent and caregiver must agree on when to start the process of toilet training and will both put forth effort in order to make the child successful at their own pace.
- At any time during this process, AELC reserves the right to stop the process and begin at a later agreed upon date.
- All children, no matter their age will be assisted in the process by the staff at the Early Learning Center.
- Appropriate clothing during the process is strongly recommended. Diapers, onesies (under legs snap shirts), tights, overalls, belts and other clothing which may make it difficult for the child to begin the self reliance aspect of toilet training are not to be worn. We recommend t-shirts and elastic waste bands pants or shorts and pull-ups or toilet training underwear.
- Pull-ups will be provide as part of the diaper stipend. Training underwear must be provided by the parent. It is the parent's responsibility to keep the diaper cubbies stocked at all times and in communication with your classroom teacher regarding any supplies.
- Additional clothing must be available in case children soil themselves. We recommend 3-4 changes of clothing including underwear and socks.
- Physical punishment or threats will never be used as a means of toilet accidents or toilet training.

Agreement: (original to be kept in child's file, copy to parent and teacher)

We the parents and the classroom teacher will make every effort towards the goal of toilet training. I understand that it is a shared process and takes every effort from the classroom teacher during school hours and the parents during non-school hours. We will keep in daily communication on the progress of the toilet training process.
